Traditionally, we say that March is the month that “comes in like a lion, and goes out like a lamb”. That’s all about the weather, of course—March is usually the transition month between deep winter, and approaching spring. However, for Christians this year, March is about the Lion of Judah, and the Lamb who was slain. February 26 was Ash Wednesday, and throughout March, we will be exploring what Jesus has to do with our lives, and how Easter matters to us.

Each Wednesday evening in March we will study one of the people present in Jesus’ ministry, and ask how our Savior changed things for that person—and for all of us. During Lent, we “church folks” have looked for ways in which we can become more like Christ in our daily lives. Years ago, that might have meant “giving up” something as a trial to see what Jesus felt as He sacrificed everything for us. But really, Lent is a long enough period of time that, if we truly want to change and become more like Jesus, we have plenty of time to begin a set of new and better habits for ourselves and our loved ones. We have time to make healthy exercise a habit. We have time for remembering to practice patience, kindness, and forgiveness—**IF** we choose to do so. Lent can be a turning point in all our lives, and God knows we could all use some more healthy and holy habits. Please plan to join us at our Lenten meals on March 4, 11, 18, 25, and April 1 as we gather for supper at 6pm. After our simple but filling meal, we will begin our study at 7pm. We will have communion around the table each evening, reminding ourselves that each time we gather, something sacred happens.

Speaking of being involved in sacred things—please plan to join us on Saturday, March 14 at 11a.m. as we celebrate the life of our beloved sister in Christ, Vicki Haugen. Of all the good and holy things God gives us, the most important is the love of the people with whom we gather to worship God. Vicki has been a special part of Spirit of Life for so many

years, and it is right and proper that we join to thank God for all the blessings she has brought us—and all the ways in which she has taught us to value our faith and our congregation. There will be a luncheon in our narthex (well, pretty much all through our church, actually!) after the celebration, when we can share favorite “Vicki memories”.

If you sing—or even if you don’t sing YET—there is room for you at the front of the sanctuary with our Praise Team on Sunday mornings. Each week our musical offering gets better as we become used to one service when we sing, and listen, and love one another as brothers and sisters in Christ. If you don’t yet know Mike Spottswood, our Minister of Music, be sure to introduce yourself and talk to him. I think there are times when I can actually **see** music dripping from his fingertips—he’s that talented! And how he loves the Lord! If you have special hymns or praise songs you’d like for us to sing, be sure to talk to Mike. Instrumentalists—your opportunity to shine on our Praise Team is also coming. Talk to Mike!!

We have so very much for which to be thankful. Our congregational cup is practically running over with chances to join, and give, and serve. Think Spring Fling. Think Palm Sunday and Easter. Think of planning and being part of VBS. And those are just a very few of the things for which all we can do is bow our heads...and say thanks be to God for all God’s blessings!!

We were very fortunate to have fresh fruit again and frozen chicken breasts. God provides for us and in turn He expects that we will serve Him well and give Him the glory.

February 11 and 12

We served 166 families on Tuesday; that is the highest on Tuesday since the end of November. On Wednesday we served 87 families which makes 253 for the week.

We continue to be blessed with food and extra items for our clients. We had fresh eggs from USDA this week and ham slices.

We can always use plastic and paper bags and thank everyone who brings them in, Pat Barron wouldn't know what to do if we didn't give a bag full to straighten. We appreciate you, Pat.

February 18 and 19

We had another great week with serving 167 families on Tuesday. On Wednesday we served 93 for a total of 260 this week.

We ended the month on a high note serving 250 families this week even though it was really raining on Tuesday. Tuesday we served 130 and Wednesday 120.

This week we had apples and oranges, milk and butter and we even had soup. Families took a very nice variety of food home.
