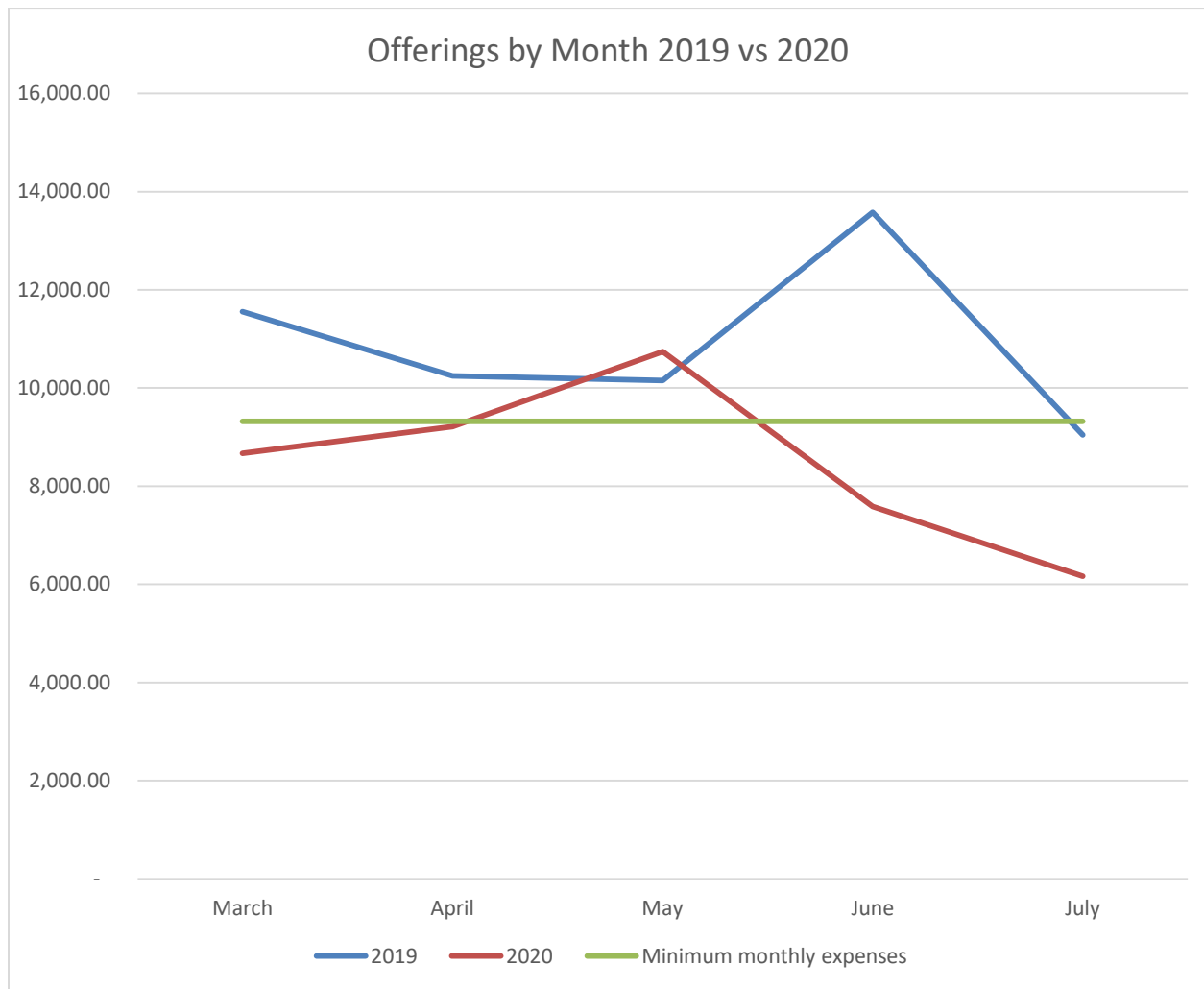
SATURDAY - OCTOBER 10TH - 10 A.M.

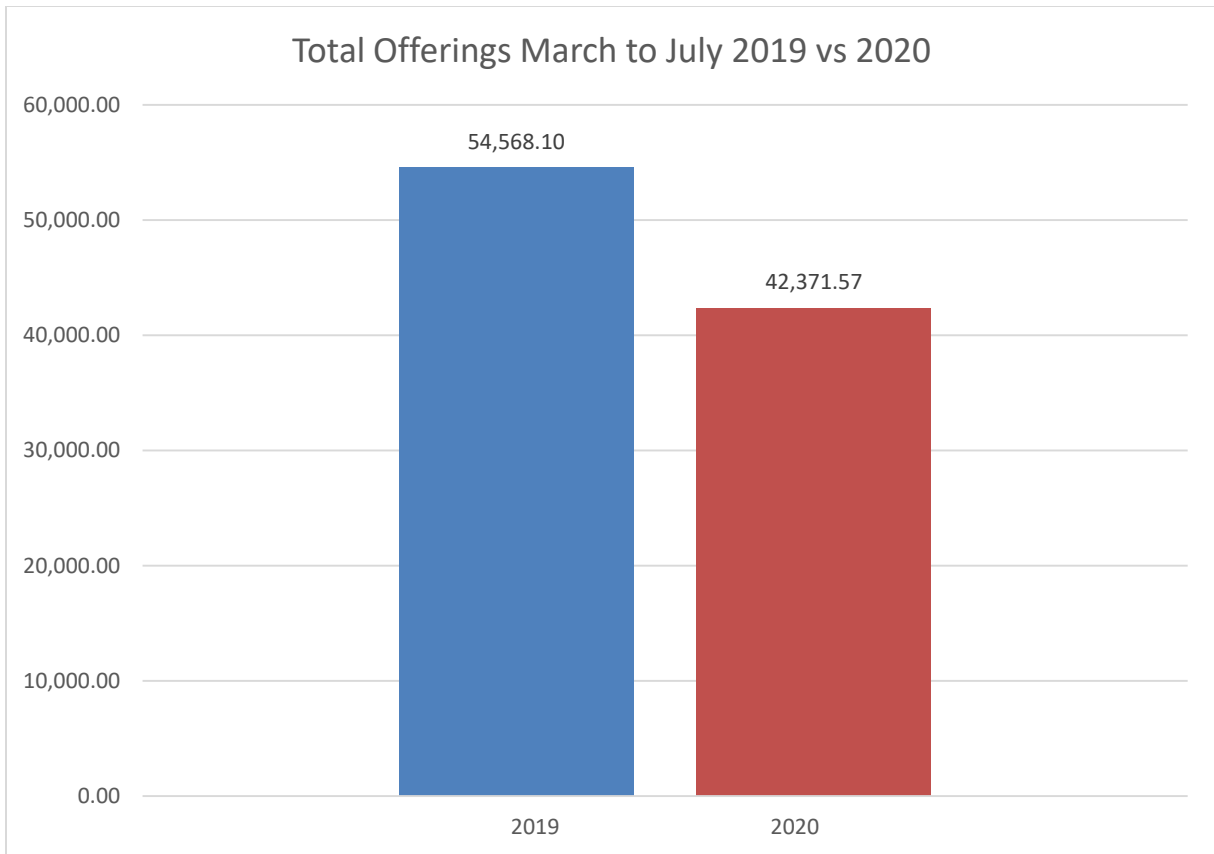
Please plan to come and help us unload. We will be receiving 3/4 of a semi truck load of pumpkins this year and need all the help we can get. Many hands make light work. This is a great opportunity for any youth to get their required volunteer hours and for all of us to be in fellowship together. Last year our sales were over \$12,000; in return we were able to retain 33.3 % of the total sales. This is our only fundraiser for the year and provides any or all support for our church projects. The pumpkins will be placed on pallets which will be a minimum of 6' apart. Since this is an open air venue and the possibility that some households will not be participating in door to door trick or treating; we anticipate that this will be one of our most successful Pumpkin Patches to date. The Pumpkin Patch will be open for business: Monday - Friday 3 - 7pm, Saturday 10am - 7 pm and Sunday 12 - 7 pm. The worship team has been making a diligent effort to keep our family connected while we were unable to be together at the church. On a weekly basis, we made the worship plan available via email or mailed to our members who are not electronically connected.

We opened our doors for worship July 12th and are together once more. We have spruced up the narthex, minimized hard surfaces and continue to ensure all are cleaned & disinfected before and after worship. For your safety, we are requiring members to have their temperature taken at the door (100 or above sorry no entry). Individual communion sets, masks & gloves are being provided and required. The sanctuary has been set up according to CDC social distancing recommendations. Currently, we are not sharing the peace, having bible study, nursery, or children's church. The children are worshiping in the sanctuary as we await the lessening of restrictions.
