FOOD PANTRY.

August 30, 2021

I forgot to make a report for July. I will include the numbers from that month as well as August.

Both months have been busy, we have been blessed with a lot of food from farm share and northeast Florida along with other contributions from the congregation and other ministries.

We have been doing fairly well with the amount of volunteers we have right now, at least on Tuesday, Mondays the day we set up for the food pantry could use a couple more hands to make the work lighter.

Coming up in October we shall be losing farm share as a supplier for of USDA foods, will be switching to Northeast Florida. At this time we are unsure of how this change will affect our food pantry. I shall try to keep everyone posted as the time gets closer.

Total number of bags handed out thru our pantry for July was 1206 families, so far in August we have handed out 1255 to families and we are expecting to have another 300 to 350 added to finish out this month.

We have not had any problems with deliveries at this time. Have been having a blessing from Farm Share, who has been able to provide us with deliveries if they have time.

We are grateful for all the donations and help we have had to keep this food pantry going, not only from the congregation, but also from those outside our church.

We could use canned vegetables, soups. We have been using them rather fast lately.

Remember our task at the food pantry and the church is to feed the lambs which at times is not only with food.
