Christian Faith Basics from the Hearts of Evangelical Lutherans

We believe God acts out of love and grace and that ultimately it is love that changes people.

We believe that what truly matters in the life of faith is God's choice of us, and not our decision to "choose" God.

We see God as both revealed and hidden. The crucified Jesus reveals to us the heart of God. Yet for us, God remains a deep and lovely mystery. We believe we need to be a bit humble when it comes to making statements about what God is up to in the world.

We believe God meets us in the ordinary world. We believe that God comes to us through earthly things like water, bread, wine, and other people. We get a little nervous when people think they have a direct pipeline to God, and that they are therefore infallible.

We believe the Bible is "living word". This living word comes from God, and invites us into a deeper relationship with God. We value it too much to claim that it is infallible or without error.

We believe that Christians live in a both/and relationship with the world. We don't despise the world, but we also don't believe the world is the ultimate reality and destination for Christians. We welcome scientific study but don't feel that life can be fully captured by scientific analysis. With God, there is always "something more".

We believe the Church is a community of faith in which there are places and roles for every single person. We believe that all of us are ministers who serve where we are called or placed by God.

We believe the Church is a creation of God, not the result of religious experiences, actions by leaders, or long-held traditions.

We believe that Christians today are connected to Christians of every time and place. We do certain things in worship, and in church life, because those things reflect our deep connection to the witnesses who have gone before us. We are people of tradition, but we believe that changing and being changed is what our tradition is all about.

We believe that, before God and in the presence of the crucified and risen Jesus, all of us are beggars. We believe that ultimately, our worth and purpose in life come as gifts from God, not from anything we do.

We believe that none of our basic faith beliefs are meant to be a barrier to prevent any person from seeking, finding, loving and living with God and with one another.
